
Transfer Station Recycling



What can be recycled at the Transfer Stations?



Newspapers, flyers & junk mail



Magazines, catalogs & phone books



Writing & computer paper



Corrugated cardboard



Boxboard
e.g. cereal, cracker & dinner boxes



Milk jugs



Plastic beverage containers
e.g. soda, water bottles



Aluminum cans



Tin cans
e.g. cat food, tuna, vegetable & soup cans



Rechargeable batteries
e.g. camera, laptop & cell phone batteries



Auto batteries



Tires
Note: Rimmed tires accrue fees



Scrap metal
e.g. bicycles, appliances, iron & copper



Wood waste
e.g. branches, wooden tables, pallets



CFL light bulbs



Used motor oil



Used clothing & Textiles



Computer towers & laptops



Propane tanks & fire extinguishers

All recyclables must be properly prepared before being brought to the transfer stations. Please rinse all plastic beverage containers, remove packing and flatten boxes, remove labels and rinse cans, eliminate all forms of liquid in scrap metal and only donate clean clothing.
