Being alert helps regulate illegal dumping by commercial enterprises who are required to pay additional fees. It limits the use of non-county residents who do not pay Kootenai County's solid waste fees. It also helps control waste volume and save our County Landfill space. Being alert saves taxpayers money.

1. Type of automobile
2. License number and state
3. Type of material dumped
4. Time and date it occurred

Rural System Overview

Kootenai County operates 12 rural residential sites for collection of household garbage. The intention of the rural sites is to provide service to those rural areas of the county that do not have private collection or other disposal facilities available locally. **The rural sites are not for disposal of any commercial waste.** The rural sites are only to be used by homeowners who have paid their Kootenai County residential solid waste fees, and only for drop off of general everyday waste collected within the home. Your cooperation in using the dumpsters as intended is appreciated.



Rural Site Locations

North Route:

Both north sites are staffed 7 days a week – 8am to 5pm

- Athol: 7222 E Howard Road, Athol - just north of State Highway 54, east of Athol
- Chilco: 20835 N Ramsey Road, Rathdrum - between Chilco Road and Diagonal Road

Southwest Route:

- Mica Flats: 6747 E Kidd Island Road - adjacent to Worley Highway District Shop
- Sun Up Bay: 13284 W Sun Up Bay Road - off of U.S. 95 South
- Worley: 9725 W B Street, Worley - off Cave Bay Road

Southeast Route:

- Blue Creek: 10632 E Yellowstone Trail - intersection of Yellowstone Trail Road and Blue Creek Road
- Carlin Bay: 1784 E Deer Road, Harrison - on Carlin Bay Creek Road, half mile east of Highway 97
- East Point: 45351 S Highway 97, Harrison - intersection of East Point Road and Highway 97
- Harrison Junction: 45901 S Highway 3, St. Maries - intersection of Highway 97 and State Highway 3
- Rose Lake: 11631 S. Highway 3, Cataldo - State Highway 3 across from Conoco Station
- Valley Mart: 31500 S Highway 3, St. Maries - State Highway 3 at Valley Mart store, Medimont
- Wolf Lodge: 5494 S Highway 97- intersection of Wolf Lodge Road and I-90

Prohibited Materials

Rural sites are designed for household residential trash only. Prohibited materials at rural locations include, but are not limited to:

- Appliances
- Batteries
- Carpet
- Construction Materials
- Furniture
- Large Bulky Items
- Liquid Waste
- Petroleum Products
- Tires
- Wood or Wood Products
- Yard Waste (Greater Than 96-Gallon Can or Equivalent)
- Any Other Hazardous Materials

We ask that these materials be disposed of at either the Prairie or Ramsey Transfer Stations.
