

Resolution 2016-89
Acceptance of Donation of Seventy Duty Weapon Lights and Holsters for
Kootenai County Sheriff's Office

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to receive real and personal property in donation, and to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Edwards-Smith Construction LLC has purchased seventy (70) TLR-1HL weapon lights and seventy (70) TDL XCalibur X2000 light bearing holsters with an estimated value of approximately \$15,400; and,

WHEREAS, Edwards-Smith Construction, LLC has offered to gift/donate the lights and holsters to Kootenai County for use by the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office personnel; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office personnel could utilize the lights and holsters in its normal course of business in providing law enforcement services in Kootenai County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Kootenai County does hereby accept the gift/donation of the seventy (70) TLR-1HL weapon lights and (70) XCalibur X2000light bearing holsters referenced hereinabove on behalf of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the seventy (70) weapon lights and seventy (70) holsters be added to Kootenai County Sheriff's property inventory and maintained by the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office in its regular course of business.
