

**Resolution 2012-93**  
**Surplus Property/9-1-1**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County 9-1-1 has in its possession 19 Motorola radios which were purchased from 1992 – 1995 and became excess with the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) mandate to migrate to narrow band frequencies by December 31, 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, these radios cannot be narrow banded and cannot be used in public service anywhere in the United States, except for Amateur Radio Service; and

**WHEREAS**, the radios have a value of less than \$250.00 or are of no value whatsoever to the County and therefore would only take up valuable storage space if retained by 9-1-1; and,

**WHEREAS**, 9-1-1 desires to have the property items declared as surplus property, so that the items may be sold through auction or donated and transferred to another governmental agency;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the equipment described above be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said property by public or private sale or to dispose of the property as it sees fit, in accordance with Idaho law.
