

**Resolution 2012-116**  
**Surplus Equipment/Office of Emergency Management**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provide that whenever any elected official has any property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Office of Emergency Management has various amateur radio antennas (see attached Exhibit 'A') which are of no further use to the county due to age and disrepair; and

**WHEREAS**, the items described hereinabove have a value of less than \$250.00; and

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Office of Emergency Management desires to have the above referenced equipment declared as surplus property;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the equipment described hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and, in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of the equipment through public auction to the highest bidder, and thereafter, if not sold at said public auction, then may dispose of said equipment as it sees fit in accordance with Idaho law.
