

**Resolution 2012-75
Destroy Records/Recorder's Office**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail records to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Recorder has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of said records has been received;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Recorder's Office, identified in Resolution 2012-74, may be destroyed as said records have surpassed their statutory retention period as public records.
