**DESTRUCTION OF COUNTY RECORDS OF THE KOOTENAI COUNTY
PROSECUTING ATTORNEY, CIVIL DIVISION**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and,

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records and legal files in the possession of the Kootenai County Prosecuting Attorney, Civil Division, has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of said records and files has been received.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the county records and legal files previously classified as temporary, semi-permanent and/or permanent by Resolution No. 2012-80 have surpassed their statutory retention period as public records and may be destroyed.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the county records and files identified in Resolution No. 2012-80 shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Clerk of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners.
