

**Resolution 2012-60
Surplus Property
Kootenai County Sheriff's Department
(Supersedes 2012-57)**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioner with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-809 and §31-829 provide that whenever any elected official has any property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department has in its possession excess equipment (see Exhibit A), which is of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, in its present condition, each piece of equipment specifically identified in Exhibit A, in its present condition has a value of less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 allows elected officials to declare unused and unwanted county property as surplus and dispose of the same through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department desires to have the above referenced equipment declared as surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the equipment described in "Exhibit A" attached hereto be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said property by public auction in accordance with Idaho law.
