

Resolution 2012-30
Surplus Vehicles/Assessor

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the County under his jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacements; and

WHEREAS the Kootenai County Assessor's Office has in its possession the following vehicles:

WHEREAS, due to the age and present mechanical condition of these vehicles, it is in the County's best interest to trade these vehicles for replacement vehicles that are better suited to fit the current needs of the Assessor's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Assessor's Office desires to have these vehicles declared as surplus property, and be allowed to trade the above vehicles for replacement vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the vehicles described hereinabove be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and, in accordance with *Idaho Code* §31-829 the Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the Assessor to trade in or exchange the above vehicles and apply the trade in or exchange value toward the purchase price of replacement vehicles.
