

Resolution 2012-106
Surplus Property/Noxious Weed Control

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Noxious Weed Control Department has in its possession a 1982 Lowe Pontoon barge, trailer and Suzuki motor which have outlived their usefulness to the department and are not cost effective to maintain; and

WHEREAS, the Noxious Weed Control Department has notified other county departments regarding the availability of the property, but no representative of the other county departments has voiced an interest in, or requested the transfer of, said property for use by their department; and,

WHEREAS, the property described hereinabove, in its present condition, has a value in excess of \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Noxious Weed Control Department desires to have the property declared as surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the property described hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of the property through public auction to the highest bidder after proper notice has been published, in accordance with *Idaho Code* 31-808, and thereafter, if not sold at said public auction, then may dispose of said property through private sale.
