

Resolution 2012-109
Surplus Equipment/Public Defender

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 and §31-829 provide that whenever any elected official has any property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Public Defender has in its possession one (1) Kyrocera 3530 Copy Machine, serial number AAJ3005039; ID# 1508 which is of no further use to the county due to age and disrepair; and

WHEREAS, the item described hereinabove has a value of less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 allows elected officials to declare unused and unwanted county property as surplus and dispose of the same through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Public Defender desires to have the above referenced equipment declared as surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the equipment described above be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said property by public or private sale or to dispose of the property as it sees fit, in accordance with Idaho law.
