

**Resolution 2012-97
Destroy Records/Auditor**

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed.

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of Kootenai County Auditor has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of said records has been received;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Auditor's Department, as identified in Exhibit "A" in Resolution 2012-96 attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, may be destroyed, as said records have surpassed their statutory retention period as public records.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the county records identified hereinabove shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Clerk of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners.
