

RESOLUTION NO. 2011- 02
SOLID WASTE - SURPLUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department has in its possession two transfer trailers, i.e., one 1994 ATSLT40 Alloy Trailer, VIN No. 1ALSL8281RS940325, and one 1994 ATSLT40 Alloy Trailer, VIN No. 1ALSL8283R5940326. These trailers are in poor condition and have outlived their useful life due to age and heavy use, and pose a safety risk resulting in a liability to the County; and,

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department has notified other county departments regarding the availability of the trailers, but no representative of the other county departments has voiced an interest in, or requested the transfer of, said trailers for use by their department; and,

WHEREAS, the trailers described hereinabove, in their present condition, have a combined value of less than \$250.00, or have no value whatsoever except as scrap metal; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department desires to have the trailers declared as surplus property and disposed of at the County's discretion.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the trailers described hereinabove be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and, in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of the trailers as it sees fit, which may include disposing of the items as scrap metal.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Tondee, seconded by Commissioner Currie, the following vote was recorded:
