

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-68
Destruction of Records of the Kootenai County Elections Department

WHEREAS, the records of the Kootenai County Elections Department are county records under Idaho Code § 34-217; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 34-217 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, an audit of certain Kootenai County Elections Department records has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of these records has been received; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners previously resolved to classify 2006 Primary-Poll Books, (2 boxes); 2008 Primary-Absentee Ballots (2 boxes); 2008 Primary-Test deck Ballots (2 boxes); 2010 Primary-unused ballots (41 boxes); 2010 Primary-voided ballots (1 box); 2010 General-unused ballots (60 boxes); 2010 General-voided ballots (1 box) and 2011 March 8th election, canvassed on March 15th School Levy-unused ballots (7 boxes), as temporary under Idaho Code §34-217; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 34-217 requires the resolution ordering destruction of county records to list, in detail, the records to be destroyed;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Elections Department listed above, are authorized to be destroyed.
