

RESOLUTION NO. 2011- 43
No Wake Zone/Parks & Waterways

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners has determined it to be a necessity to classify a “no wake zone” for the protection and safety of the environment and the citizenry of Kootenai County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that certain areas are in need of environmental protection from erosion as a result of wakes created by motor-driven watercraft; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interests of all residents of Kootenai County that certain areas be designated as “no wake zones”; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County owns various parcels which provide access to waterways and recreational opportunities for the public; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Board of County Commissioners to manage the use of these parcels to benefit the health, safety, and welfare of the recreational users, the adjoining landowners, and the public in general; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the following areas shall be designated as restricted zones in Kootenai County, Idaho, as defined in Ordinance No. 279A as follows:

RESTRICTED ZONES

- I. No Wake Zones.
 - A. The waterway within two hundred feet of shore, running parallel to the entire length of the Hayden Lake Dam and spillway, at Honeysuckle Bay in Hayden Lake.
