

**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-45**  
**KOOTENAI COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT – SURPLUS BOATS**

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

**WHEREAS**, Idaho Code §31-808(9) vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to grant or exchange with the federal government, the state of Idaho, any political subdivision or taxing district of the State of Idaho, or any local historical society, with or without compensation, any real or personal property, if the same is in the public interest, after proper notice has been published; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department is in possession of the following boats:

1988 21 foot Almar Patrol Boat, HIN No. AUC22601B989, with EZ-Loader Trailer  
1981 20 foot Apollo Workboat, HIC No. 20 RB VAA 001030781, with EZ-Loader Trailer

The 1988 Almar Patrol Boat is not operational and is in need of repair, and the 1981 Apollo Workboat is without a motor and has been in storage for approximately the last six years, during which time it was used only once; and,

**WHEREAS**, the above-referenced boats are not functional for the needs of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department, thereby rendering the boats useless to Kootenai County; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Hauser Lake Fire Department, an authorized taxing District within the state of Idaho, has expressed an interest in obtaining the above-referenced boats from Kootenai County; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department desires to gift the above referenced boats to the Hauser Lake Fire Department.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the BOCC finds that the grant of the above property to the Hauser Lake Fire Department is in the public interest as the County no longer has a use for the boats and Hauser Lake Fire has a use for them and the transfer of the property will benefit the residents within the Fire District and the gifting of the property will not harm Kootenai County and will financially benefit the Fire Department. The boats hereinabove described be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and, in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may dispose of said boats by sale, donation, or other means in accordance with Idaho law.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Tondee, the following vote was recorded:
