**DESTRUCTION OF COUNTY RECORDS OF THE KOOTENAI COUNTY  
PROSECUTING ATTORNEY, CIVIL DIVISION**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed.

**WHEREAS**, an audit of certain county records in the possession of Kootenai County Prosecuting Attorney, Civil Division, has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of said records has been received;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the county records and files previously classified as temporary, semi-permanent and/or permanent by Resolution No. 2011-128, have surpassed their statutory retention period as public records and may be destroyed.

**BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED** that the destruction and disposition of the county records identified hereinabove shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Clerk of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners.
