

Resolution 2011-120
Surplus Property
34010 S. Hwy 97, Harrison, Idaho

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment, is of no further use to the county, he may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, dispose of such property; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County is the title owner of a parcel of real property located at 34010 S. Hwy 97, Harrison Idaho, to-wit:

more particularly described in "Exhibit A" attached

As well as the structure located on said real property;

WHEREAS, the East Side Fire Protection District has scheduled to burn the structure at 34010 S. Highway 97, Harrison, Idaho; and

WHEREAS, East Side Fire Protection District has agreed to burn this structure for the convenience of Kootenai County and to save the tax payers money; and

WHEREAS, the building located on the above-described real property remains vacant, and the Kootenai County Commissioners have determined that the building is of no further use to the County, due to its age and deteriorating status, and therefore desire to have the building, but not the real property upon which the building is located, declared as an item of surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the building located upon the real property described above be and hereby is, declared to be surplus property and, in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of the building by any means available, including fire.
