

RESOLUTION NO. 2011- 38
KOOTENAI COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT
SURPLUS VEHICLES

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-808 provides that property classified as being valued under \$250 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department is in possession of the following vehicles:

2004 Chevrolet Astro, VIN No. 1GNEL19X54B119795 – 142,969 miles
1991 Ford Taurus, VIN No. 1FACP52U9MG217345 – 107,007 miles
1993 Ford Van, VIN No. 1FMDA21X6PZB43686 – 169,344 miles
1993 Chevy Caprice, VIN No. 1G1BL53E5PR126017 – 136,194 miles
1993 Chevy Caprice, VIN No. 1GBL53E1PR126497 – 157,405 miles
1992 Chevy Caprice, VIN No. 1G1BL5376N4125957 – 179,297 miles

These vehicles, originally part of the Sheriff's fleet, have encountered various mechanical and electrical problems, have high odometer readings, are unreliable and pose safety risks due to age and present condition; and,

WHEREAS, it would not be cost effective for Kootenai County to repair and maintain these vehicles, thereby rendering the vehicles useless to the Sheriff's Department; and,

WHEREAS, each of the vehicles described hereinabove, in its present condition, has a value of less than \$250.00; and,

WHEREAS, due to reliability and safety issues, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department has not notified other county departments regarding the availability of the above-referenced vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department desires to have the above-referenced vehicles declared as surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the vehicles described hereinabove be, and hereby are, declared to be surplus property, and, in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to sell the vehicles through public auction to

the highest bidder using the County's contracted auctioneer, propertyroom.com, and if not sold at said public auction, then may dispose of said vehicles through private sale or other means in accordance with Idaho law.

Upon a motion to adopt the text of the foregoing Resolution made by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Green, the following vote was recorded:
