

Resolution 2011-41
Kootenai County Solid Waste Department
2011 Rural Systems Strategy

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners met with representatives of the Solid Waste Department on March 21, 2011 to discuss the status of the department, fiscal and long-range planning for solid waste projects and/or programs; and,

WHEREAS, Kootenai County is required by Idaho Code to provide solid waste services for the Citizens of Kootenai County; and

WHEREAS, Kootenai County has funded and operated a solid waste system for over 20 years that meets the needs of the County; and

WHEREAS, existing facilities and components of the Solid waste system have limits and better alternatives are desired; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners feels that it is in the best interest of Kootenai County that the Solid Waste Department should own the property upon which the Rural Residential Collection Sites are located to mitigate liability to the County and to allow future development for the needs of the public and the system; and,

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department has developed a Rural Systems Strategy to meet the future requirements of rural residents of Kootenai County for waste transfer and disposal while providing a convenient, efficient and cost-effective handling system that improves solid waste infrastructure and is inherently safer than previous waste handling systems; and,

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the Rural Systems Strategy, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is a living document that is subject to change as a result of circumstance, need and want.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department's 2011 Rural Systems Strategy be officially approved and adopted.
