

**Resolution 2010-107**  
**Exchange or Trade-in of Personal Property/KCSD**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the County under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment is obsolete, worn or damaged so as to require replacement and is of greater value on a trade in or exchange for replacements than upon the sale as above permitted, he may, incident to purchase of such replacements and with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, trade in or exchange such personal property and apply its trade-in or exchange value on the purchase price of replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department has the following obsolete, worn or damaged guns, to wit:

108 S & W Handguns with 3 magazines per gun; and  
77 H & K Handguns with 3 magazines per gun;

**WHEREAS**, the guns described above have outlived their usefulness to the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department desires to use the guns as trade-in property for the purchase of replacement guns for use by the Sheriff's Department; and

WHEREAS, the guns described above are of greater value on a trade-in or exchange than upon sale and purchase; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners consent to the trade-in of the guns described above;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department is hereby authorized to use the guns identified above as trade-in property for the purchase of replacement guns.
