

**Resolution 2010-47**  
**Destruction of Records/Elections**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and,

**WHEREAS**, an audit of certain county records maintained by the Kootenai County Elections Department has been performed and legal advice regarding the disposal of these records has been received; and,

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* § 31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and,

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* § 9-331A(5) allows for the retention of records by electronic means and the destruction of the original; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the business records of the Kootenai County Elections Department as identified below are authorized to be stored by electronic means pursuant to the requirements of *Idaho Code* § 9-331A, and that the original documents, as identified, may be destroyed: Voted Ballots, Voted Envelopes, Ballot Stubs, Duplicated Ballots, Write-in Ballots, Test Deck Ballots – Primary , Test Deck Ballots – General, Test deck for 2007 City Elections.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the transfer to electronic means and destruction and disposition of the business records identified above shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Clerk of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners.
