

Resolution 2010-86
Surplus Property/Canon Copier

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and,

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-808 provides that property classified as being valued under \$250 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners has in its possession one Canon Image Runner Copier 330S, Serial No. NQJ29139, which was being utilized for copying purposes by staff working at the Kootenai County Information Desk and by Kootenai County security officers; and,

WHEREAS, due to advancements in technology, Canon no longer supports the Canon copier, rendering the equipment outdated and obsolete and of no further use to Kootenai County; and,

WHEREAS, the Canon copier, due to its age and present condition, has a value of less than \$250.00, or is of no value whatsoever, and therefore would only take up valuable storage space if retained by Kootenai County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board staff has notified other county departments regarding the availability of the Canon copier but has received no interest in, or request for, the transfer of said copier and,

WHEREAS, the Board desires to have the copier declared as surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Canon Image Runner Copier 330S, Serial No. NQJ29139, referenced hereinabove be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and, in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of the copier as it sees fit through private sale using the County's contracted auctioneer, propertyroom.com, or through other means in accordance with Idaho law.
