

Resolution 2009-91
Establishing Official Holidays for Calendar Year 2010

WHEREAS, Kootenai County Policy No. 312 designates ten (10) official holidays for County Employees; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have determined that County offices shall be allowed to close early at 3:00 p.m. on the Friday following Thanksgiving and at 3:00 p.m. on Christmas Eve for the year 2010; and

WHEREAS, if Elected Officials decide that an employee is unable to leave early (i.e. – essential services) on the designated day(s), then they shall be compensated those two hours at a later date (comp time) to be determined by the Department Manager or Elected Official. Further, if a vacation day is planned, those two hours do not need to be claimed as vacation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that effective immediately, the following will be the official County holidays for the calendar year 2010:

Thanksgiving	Fourth Thursday in November
Christmas	December 24, 2010
