

Resolution 2009-94 Surplus Oil Canisters

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the County under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the County, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means;

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-808 provides that property classified as being valued under \$250 may be sold through a private sale without notice of public auction; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Solid Waste Department has in its possession ten (10) Harvard Oil Filter Canisters which were purchased in the late 1980's to assist the Department's effort to filter and clean the oil it utilized in specific equipment operated by the Solid Waste Department in an attempt to extend the life expectancy of the oil and the equipment; and,

WHEREAS, after the Solid Waste Department acquired the oil filter canisters, the Department switched to a new oil and a new maintenance program that was far more successful and cost effect, thereby rendering the oil filter canisters useless to the Department and now outdated, due to the passage of time; and,

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department has been storing the ten (10) oil filter canisters in hope that another use would be found, or that the canisters could be transferred or sold to another entity; and,

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department has been approached by a representative of LE Oil who has examined the oil filter canisters and, based upon their present condition, has offered to purchase all ten (10) of the canisters, three (3) for the sum of \$50 each, and the remaining seven (7) for the sum of \$100 each, for a total of \$850; and,

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Department is of the opinion that the offer made by LE Oil is fair and desires to sell the ten (10) oil filter canisters to the LE Oil representative at the stated price for use or recycling by LE Oil;

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the personal property described above be, and hereby is, classified as property worth less than \$250.00 per I.C. §31-808, and as such, may be declared to be surplus property, and, in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of such property as it sees fit.
