

**RESOLUTION NO. 2009-19**  
**CLASSIFICATION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY AS SURPLUS PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County;

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* § 31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his jurisdiction or control which, in his judgment, is of no further use to the county, he may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means;

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Solid Waste is in possession of four (4) transfer trailers which are of no further use to their department, to-wit:

1991 Ace Transfer Trailer, VIN No. 1A9230034M0074591,  
purchased June 28, 1991, for \$38,771.00;

1991 Ace Transfer Trailer, Model WFT402, VIN  
No. 1A9230052M0074591, purchased June 28, 1991, for \$38,771.00;

1993 Alloy Transfer Trailer, Model ATSLT40, VIN  
No. 1ALSL8283PS931266, purchased April 19, 1993, for \$36,350.00;  
and,

1996 Alloy Transfer Trailer, Model ATSLT40, VIN  
No. 1ALSL8285TS961444, purchased June 15, 1996, for \$40,975.00.

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Solid Waste has notified other county departments through various means regarding the availability of the transfer trailers identified above, but has received no interest in, need of, or request for the transfer of said property;

**WHEREAS**, Kootenai County Solid Waste desires to have the four (4) transfer trailers classified as surplus property;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the four (4) transfer trailers identified above, be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property and, in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to sell said equipment at auction to the highest bidder after advertising the same as surplus property, or dispose of the same in accordance with Idaho law.
