

Resolution No. 2009-85

Transfer of County Property/Snowgroomers to Parks & Waterways

WHEREAS, Idaho Code §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and,

WHEREAS, Kootenai County is the title owner of a 1987 Maxe Trailer, Serial No. MM9FG3264H1LE2301, which has been utilized for many years in the Snowgroomer Program; and,

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Snowgroomer Board has determined that the Snowgroomer Program has no further use for the 1987 Maxe Trailer and requests the authority to transfer ownership of the trailer to the Kootenai County Parks & Waterways Department, without consideration, as it is in the public interest; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners concurs with the recommendation of the Kootenai County Snowgroomer Board that the 1987 Maxe Trailer is of no further use to the Kootenai County Snowgroomer Program, and that it is in the public interest to transfer the trailer to the Parks & Waterways Department, without consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Kootenai County does hereby authorize the Kootenai County Snowgroomer Board to transfer the 1987 Maxe Trailer referenced above, without consideration, to the Parks & Waterways Department, as such transfer is in the public interest.
